Minutes of the Regular Meeting of January 14, 2015

1. CALL TO ORDER

President Drew Sernus called the meeting to order at 6:37 p.m.

3. PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

President Sernus led the Pledge of Allegiance.

4. SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT

A. Staff and Student Recognition

Joe Zampillo commended the Worth Junior High students and staff for collecting spare change for a family whose child attends Worth Elementary and was recently diagnosed with a rare brain disease. The efforts spearheaded by the Worth Junior High Student Council and under the direction of Lisa Bray and Colleen DeGonia raised \$765 that was donated to the family prior to the holidays. The Junior High advisory classes also sent cards. Dr. Wojtylewski stated she recently became aware of a fundraising event that will be held on May 9th. Additional information will be shared with the Board in a Friday memo.

B. Facility Projects Update

Dr. Wojtylewski stated that the Worth Elementary HVAC project punch list should be completed by the end of the next week. The units are very quiet and provide no disruption to the classes.

Dr. Wojtylewski stated that the bid process for the Worth Elementary Boiler/HVAC project will begin in early February. The project start will likely be delayed by two days because of emergency school closings on January 7th and 8th due to dangerously cold temperatures.

Bob Moyer reported that the wireless access project was completed over winter break and the wireless units have been activated. He is working with E2 Services to address issues with wireless printing which should be remedied within 24 hours. E2 Services also setup the weather stations at Worth Elementary (2 stations), Worthwoods (2 stations), and Worth Junior High (4 stations). He showed the Board members the device that is used by each station to monitor weather conditions and communicate data for use in the classrooms. Dr. Wojtylewski stated she was very pleased with the management of the project and the responsiveness of E2 Services.

C. Lunch Program

As previously discussed with the Board members, Dr. Wojtylewski stated that beginning in February the district will offer students a "cold" lunch option. The Board members were given a copy of the letter that will be sent home to parents explaining the guidelines for ordering a lunch and a menu for February.

Dr. Wojtylewski provided the Board with a letter sent to Dr. Kinder advising her that District 127 has five seats open for the next consolidated election and only four candidates will be running. Dr. Wojtylewski will check with legal counsel regarding the process for filling the vacancy. Dr. Wojtylewski also shared information sent by Dr. Kinder on a candidate briefing session being sponsored by the South Cook Intermediate Service Center for potential first-time school board candidates and current members of school boards. The Board members were in agreement that Dr. Wojtylewski should share the information with Mrs. Egan who has been identified by the County Clerk as a candidate in the upcoming election.
