Dear Parents/Guardians:

On Friday, a court ruling in Springfield resulted in a temporary restraining order prohibiting the Governor from enforcing his executive orders that require masks for all students, teachers, staff, and visitors. In light of this order, starting on Monday, February 7, Worth 127 is recommending students, teachers, staff, and visitors wear a mask while in school buildings, however, this recommendation is not an enforceable mandate.

Please note that **the order** issued by the Judge **is in the appeal process** at the appellate court level, and the district will be required to reassess if the ruling is “stayed” or reversed. If the school district is required to return to the original mandates, I will inform you as soon as possible.
