Parents/guardians seeking an objection in accordance with the right to the free exercise of religious belief should complete Parts I and III.

Parents should submit this form to Mrs. Linda Esposito, Director of Curriculum and Instruction. Upon review of the form, a determination will be made about the request for exemption from the instructional material or program which is the basis of the objection.
