On May 27, 2021 at 10:00 AM, a meeting will be conducted by Worth School District 127, due to the current COVID-19 pandemic, the meeting will be via teleconference. The purpose of this meeting is to discuss how Worth School District 127 will serve students with disabilities who attend private schools or who are home-schooled within the district during the 2021/2022 school year. In accordance with the requirements of the Federal Individuals with Disabilities Education Act of 2004 (“IDEA 2004”), public school districts are required to spend a portion of their Federal Part B special education funds in order to provide identified students with disabilities who attend private schools with the opportunity to equitably participate in special education services offered by the district. As part of the process, we must conduct a public meeting in order to discuss our plans to fulfill that responsibility for the coming school year. In addition, we wish to hear your feedback and views in order to ensure that your voices are heard during this process. Finally, we wish to also share information about how students with suspected disabilities can access the process offered by our district to screen and evaluate those suspected disabling conditions.
