Dear Parents/Guardians:

This letter is to inform you that a student at Worth Elementary has tested positive for COVID-19. Administrators and health officials review every COVID-19 scenario in detail with careful consideration given to contact tracing. Because of the unique circumstances with this current situation, the Cook County Department of Public Health (CCDPH) recommended that the district quarantine all Early Childhood and Pre-Kindergarten students. The Early Childhood and Pre-Kindergarten students will attend school remotely until Thursday, May 6. As always, Worth 127 will follow the recommendations provided by the CCDPH.

The district is following mitigation protocols and coordinating efforts with the Cook County Department of Public Health. State and local health departments' guidance for best practices and procedures to protect everyone's health will continue to be followed.


To prevent the spread of the disease, the following steps are followed:
