Drop-Off / Pick-Up Procedures

Arrival @ 8:15 - 8:30 AM

- Grades 1-5 and AM K: Gym Doors
- PM K: Door 2, first door North side of the building
- Follow the circular pattern towards the back of the north parking lot.
- All students will enter the Gym doors starting at 8:15
- Students should exit from the passenger side of the car only.
- Pull as far forward as possible to allow 3-4 cars to unload at one time.

Dismissal @ 3:15

- Grades K,1: Door 2, first door North side
- Grades 2-3: Door 3, second door North side (with ramp)
- Grade 4-5: Gym doors
- Plan to arrive between 2:55 3:10 as we **close** the parking lot at **3:12**.
- Back into a parking spot or line up in rows at the back of the parking lot.
- The parking lot will reopen once all children have safely cleared the area.
- Cars will be dismissed from front to back.
