- Early Childhood will not attend in person but will have remote instruction. Pre-K is not in session for all early dismissal dates.
- AM and PM Kindergarten will alternate attending AM in person except on December 20. Kindergarten is not in session on December 20.

- Back into a parking spot or line up in rows at the back of the parking lot.
- The parking lot will reopen once all children have safely cleared the area.
- Cars will be dismissed from front to back.
