As we return to school with full bellies and warm hearts after having spent some much needed family time, we come back to a time when some of our families celebrate holidays and some do not. Dec 17th EARLY DISMISSAL: Students will dismiss early on December 17th for Winter Break. All bus services (Alpha, RAS, Penny Lane, and High Hopes) have been alerted to the time change.

Construction Updates: Construction at Worth Elementary continues on schedule. The asphalt for the dropoff lanes behind the school has been laid and striped.
